Dear East Mountain Womenade Supporter,

We are proud to present you with our 2024 Annual Financial Report. Since its inception, as of the end of 2024, East Mountain Womenade provided \$266,761 of emergency financial assistance to families who have experienced crises such as job loss, domestic violence, death of family members, and various other situations.

So far in 2025, your donations have provided 19 families with an additional \$12,138 of assistance, bringing our total to **\$278,899**. Aid included filling propane tanks, covering emergency dental bills, car repairs, paying utility bills, purchasing firewood and groceries, and paying rent. We are truly grateful for all the financial support we receive from our donors during our potluck fundraising season, and through workplace giving and United Way. We want to thank the Mountain Garden club members for their annual donations during their holiday luncheon. We want to remind you that 100% of your donation goes to the families. All overhead expenses such as postage and other incidentals are paid by the Board members.

Thank you again for your continued support. Together we are making a difference to families in the East Mountains.

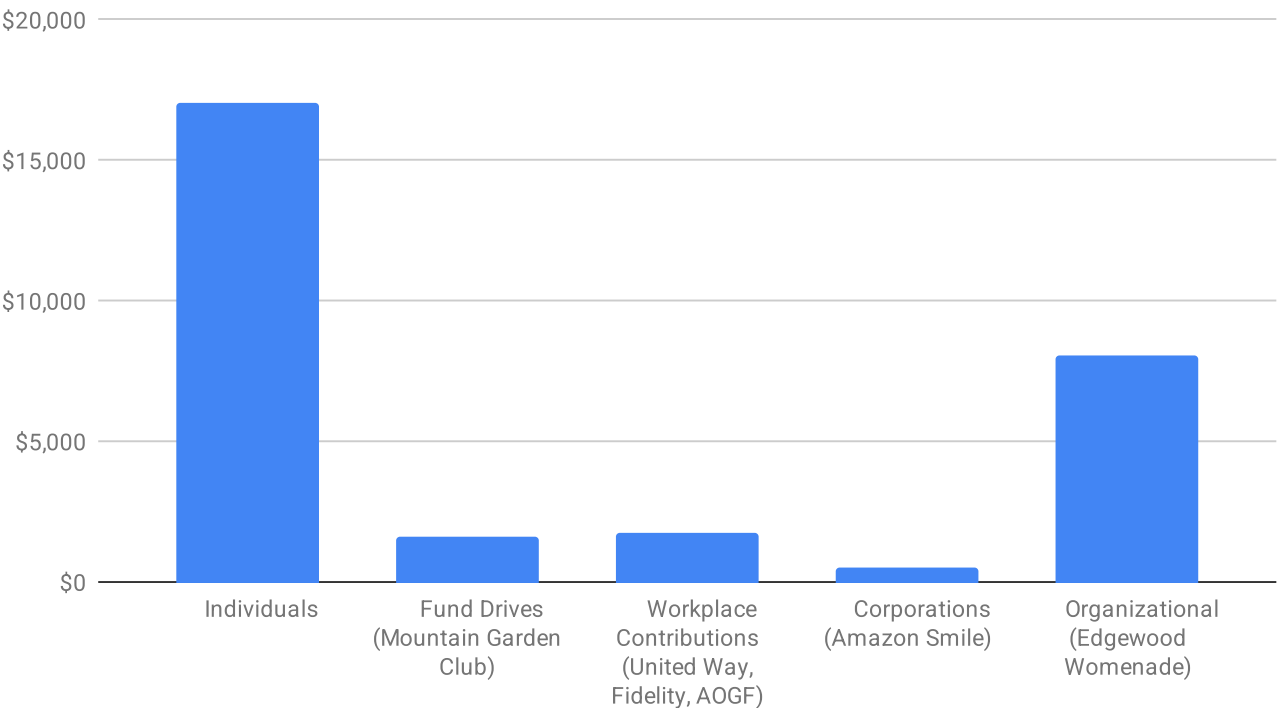

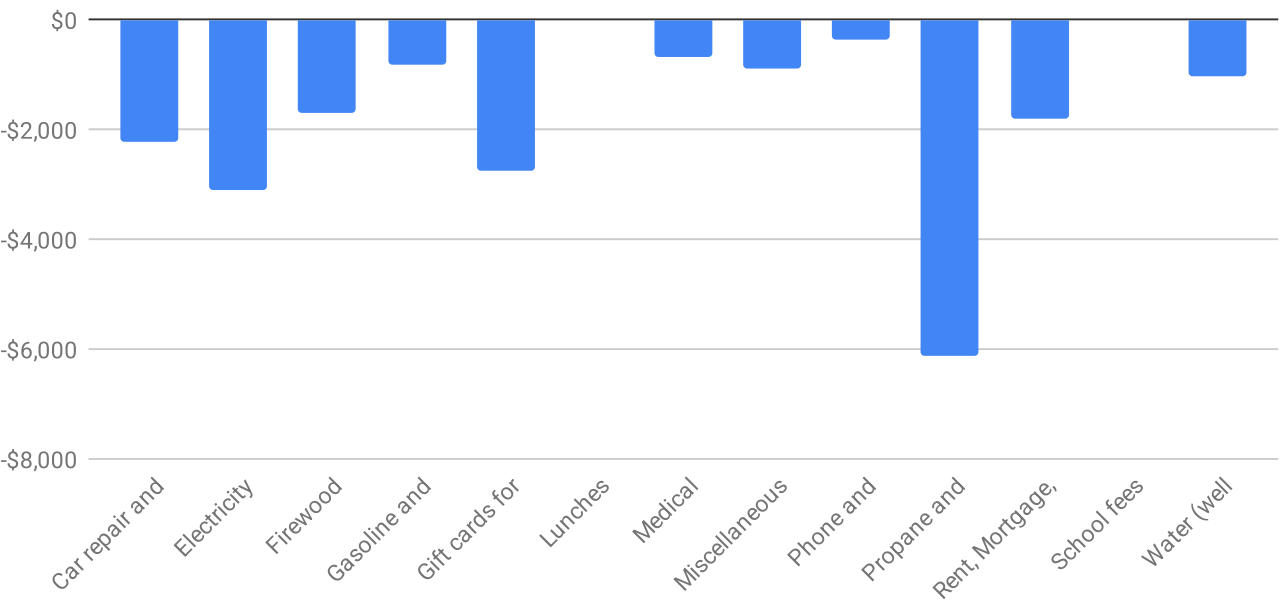
